- **Garden Opening and Closing Dates:**

- There will be a meeting of all gardeners on Wednesday, April 25th at 6-8 pm in the first floor conference room in the City Offices located at 575 Dorset Street.
- The opening day will be announced in the May e-Newsletter or facebook (approximately first week of May).
- Tilling will be done annually in the spring by the Parks Division of the South Burlington Public Works Department, as soon as weather permits.
- The closing day and final cleanup of the gardens will Sunday, October 14, 2018. This is a week earlier than last year to allow time for the gardens to be tilled again in the fall, weather permitting.
- If your plot is not cleared out prior to this day, everything in your plot will be removed and disposed of, and your status as a returning gardener will be in jeopardy.
